### 5. CHIEF'S REPORT (DC Jim Mathias):

- A. Chief Bartsch is on vacation
- B. Update on north state large fires—Dixie, and the new Caldor, in El Dorado NF.
- C. Cal Fire has a shortage of engines due to the number of fires in the state, and has requested local government engines—our Engines 62 and 63 are rented out.
- D. The Loma Fire was 12 acres total, the only fire in the District this month; the Glen Fire was 184 acres and caused by a vehicle; the Frenchtown Fire was 40 acres.
- E. The Plyovent system is installed and working

#### 6. GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT:

- A. GM Shields has a list from the county of people who are licensed as spray applicators for weed abatement.
- B. GM Shields is working on assessments for the tax assessors office. Forty-two properties have changed parcel numbers. The District must purchase the disk from the county for \$185 to review and validate.
- C. GM Shields contacted the District's legal counsel about the bidding process for the water tank at Station 61. Bordsen stated engineered plans need to be made available for the bids, without an RFP. Discussed using plans from the tank at Station #63
